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The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 32, 35(1) and Section 35(3) and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 January 2021 and may be cited as the City of Manchester (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2020.

INTERPRETATION

- 2 (1) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"active registered session" means that payment has been made for the parking period which has not expired;

"chargeable hours" means the hours specified in Column 3 of Schedule 3 to this Order,

"Council" means Manchester City Council,

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004,

"collecting" and "delivering" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"credit card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act,

"debit card" has the same meaning as in Section 35A of the Act;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000,

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge being a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 to be included in an order under the Act, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers,

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in off street parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the said parking place,

"e-permit" means an electronic version of a parking permit issued and confirmed by the Council or other authorised agent of the Council and to be valid must be registered on the approved electronic database approved by the Council or other authorised agent of the Council,

"electric vehicle" means a vehicle in which the electrical motive power is derived from an internal electrical storage battery that can be plugged into mains electricity for the purpose of recharging the said battery and shall include any vehicle that is so powered in part by such a battery, including plug-in hybrid and extended-range electric vehicles,

"electric vehicle recharging parking place" means a designated parking place to be used as an electric vehicle recharging parking place in accordance with Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016,

"electric vehicle recharging point" means equipment situated adjacent to an electric vehicle recharging parking place that supplies electric energy for recharging the battery of electric vehicle via connection to an electric cable;

"free parking period" means the first 1 hour and 30 minutes once a parking session has been registered in accordance with Article 26 of this Order and shall only apply to School Lane North Car Park and School Lane South Car Park;

"hand-held device" means a wireless hand-held computer used by a civil enforcement officer which is programmed to interface with the telephone payment parking system,

"mobile telephone" means wireless telepathy apparatus (as defined in the Wireless Telepathy Act 1949) designed or adapted for the purpose of transmitting and receiving verbal and text messages so as to provide a telephone which is connected to a public electronic communications networks (within the meaning of the Communications Act 2003) and is not physically connected to a landline,

"motor car" means a mechanically propelled vehicle constructed or adapted to carry not more than seven passengers exclusive of the driver, or any other vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed three tonnes and a half,

"motorcycle" means a mechanically propelled (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than four wheels of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410kg and not having a sidecar attached,

"parking bay" means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle and which is marked in the manner specified in Article 4 of this Order,

"parking charge" means the amounts specified in Column 5 of Schedule 2 to this Order;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured blue and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, which has not ceased to be valid;

" parking permit" means a residents permit, council staff season ticket or a standard season ticket which has been issued by the council or any agent authorised by the said Council in accordance with the provisions of this Order,

"parking place" means any area of land specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order for use as a parking place and within which parking bays may be indicated,

"pay by mobile phone" means a method of payment by mobile telephone or electronic means and, on first use, registration of the relevant registration plate of the vehicle, location of the parking place, credit or debit card details or such other details as the Council may from time to time require which is accepted by the Council as a valid method of payment for the relevant time of use of the parking place;

"pay station" means an apparatus or device of a type and design for the purpose inter alia of this Order, being apparatus designed to receive payment in respect of the parking place;

"pedal cycle" means a unicycle, bicycle or tricycle or cycle having four or more wheels not being in any case mechanically propelled unless it is an electrically assisted pedal cycle of such class as is to be treated as not being a motor vehicle for the purposes of the Act,

'recharging' in relation to an electric vehicle means an electric vehicle which is connected by electric cable to an the electric vehicle recharging point situated adjacent to an electric vehicle recharging parking place specified in the Schedule to this Order for the purpose of recharging the battery of the electric vehicle ,

"registered keeper" is the person for the time being registered with the Driving and Vehicle Licensing Agency as the person recorded as keeping the vehicle and the person named on the Vehicle Registration Document. The registered 'keeper is not necessarily either the legal owner of the vehicle or the driver or user of the vehicle for the time being

"transaction fee" means the charge payable by the applicant to cover the administration of the operator and costs incurred during the transaction process These charges cover the costs of a text message reminder sent to the driver's mobile telephone prior to the expiry of the parking period for which payment has been made by the parking charge and /or a text message sent to the driver's mobile telephone confirming payment of the parking charge has been made Telephony charges incurred in the costs of making the transaction depend on network provider and phone service and are the responsibility of the applicant,

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether by animal or mechanical power;

(2) For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying. -

(a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if: -

(i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard of facia of the vehicle, or

- (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or facia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position of the vehicle

so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle,

- (b) a parking disc is in the relevant position if. -

- (i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or facia of the vehicle; or
- (ii) where the vehicle does not have a dashboard or facia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

DESIGNATION OF PARKING PLACES

- 3. Each area of land which is described in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order may be used subject, to the provisions of this Order as a parking place for vehicles

LAYING OUT AND MARKING OF PARKING PLACES

- 4. The limits of each parking place and the limits of every parking bay in that parking place shall be indicated in such manner as the Council may determine by lines, studs or other indications

VEHICLES WHICH MAY USE PARKING PLACES

- 5. Each parking place may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order for the leaving of vehicles of such classes as are specified in relation to that parking place in Column 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 6. Where in the Schedules to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, no person shall permit the vehicle to wait in that parking place unless it is of the specified class.

RESTRICTIONS OF USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 7. No person shall, except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drive or permit to be driven any vehicle in the parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place
- 8. No person shall use any vehicle while it is in the parking place in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale or hire of his skill or services
- 9. No person shall, wash, clean or overhaul any vehicle or execute any mechanical or other alterations or repairs to the vehicle while it is in the parking place except such repairs as

may be essential for the purpose of enabling the vehicle to be towed or driven away from the parking place.

10. No person shall use any part of the parking place or any vehicle left in the parking place for sleeping, camping or cooking.
11. The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
12. The driver of a vehicle using the parking place shall not sound the horn or similar instrument except for the avoidance of danger when about to change the position of a vehicle in or departing from the parking place.
13. Where, within the parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for a disabled person's vehicle the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the parking bay unless it is a disabled person's vehicle which is carrying the disabled person and which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge.
14. Where, within the parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for vehicles displaying a valid parking permit the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the parking bay unless it displays in the relevant position a valid parking permit.
15. Where in the parking place signs have been erected or surface markings laid out for the purpose of indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place or indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance, leaves the parking place otherwise by an exit or proceeds in a direction contrary to that specified.
16. Where at or near the entrance to the parking place there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that the parking place is available only to vehicles under a specified height, width, length or weight or only at certain times no person shall cause or permit to enter the parking place any vehicle which exceeds that height, width, length or weight or outside those times.
17. Where within the parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay is available only for the recharging of electric vehicles the driver of a vehicle shall not permit the vehicle to wait in the electric vehicle recharging parking bay unless it is an electric vehicle and the said electric vehicle is recharging from an electric vehicle recharging point whilst in occupation of the electric vehicle recharging parking bay

AMOUNT OF PARKING CHARGE AT PARKING PLACES

- 18 The parking charge for a vehicle left in the parking place during the chargeable hours shall be in accordance with the parking charges specified in Column 5 of Schedule 2 to this Order for the parking period specified in Column 4 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

MAXIMUM PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT

- 19 The driver of a vehicle shall not be permitted to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in the Schedules to this Order in relation to that parking place.

PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE- TICKETLESS PARKING SYSTEM

20. Except as provided in Article 29 to this Order and in accordance with the provisions of Article 5 of this Order, no person shall leave any vehicle during the permitted hours in a parking place specified in Schedule 1 to this Order without having paid the appropriate parking charge in accordance with the charges specified in Column 5 of Schedule 2 to this Order, in respect of the parking period specified in Column 4 of Schedule 2 to this Order; PROVIDED that for the purposes of this Article if a vehicle when first placed in a parking place is exempt from payment of any charge by virtue of the provisions of Article 29 of this Order and continues to wait in that parking place otherwise than in accordance with those provisions the parking charge shall be treated as having been incurred and to be payable at the time when the vehicle ceased to wait by virtue of those provisions and all the provisions of this Order shall then apply accordingly.
- 21 Subject to Articles 29 and 35 of this Order, the parking charge shall be payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking place specified in the Schedules to this Order either by -

ON SITE CASHLESS PAYMENT

- (1) Entering the vehicle registration plate at the pay station and purchasing a period of time for parking of the vehicle,
- (i) payment for the parking period shall be made by a debit card or a credit card ,
 - (ii) the pay station shall display a confirmation message that payment has been accepted and registered for the period of time purchased;
 - (iii) this transaction shall be digitally transmitted to the Council removing the requirement to display a ticket;
 - (iv) no ticket will be issued by the ticket machine,
 - (v) a receipt will be issued should the driver require;

OR

PAY BY MOBILE PHONE

- (2) Making payment using a mobile phone in accordance with the instructions set out on signs located at or in the vicinity of the pay station or on the pay station.
- (i) Confirmation of payment shall be indicated by a verbal message or a text message where paid for under Article 22 sent to the mobile telephone of the driver indicating confirmation of the location of the parking place for which the parking charge has been accepted and the

time at which the parking period for which payment of the parking charge has been made will expire

22. Where the parking charge is paid in accordance with the provisions of Article 21(2) to this Order a transaction fee shall be payable in addition to the parking charge.
23. A transaction fee shall not be payable in the case of the following
 - (i) For confirmation of the payment of the parking charge to be sent By electronic mail;
 - (ii) For confirmation of the payment of VAT has made to be sent by electronic mail.
24. Where the driver attempts to pay the parking charge in accordance with Article 21 (1) but is unable to do so he shall pay the parking charge in accordance with Article 21 (2).
25. (1) Where in a carpark, there is a free parking period the vehicle registration plate must be entered at the pay station at the time of parking and the free parking period shall start to run,
(2) On expiry of the free parking period the parking charge shall be payable.

INDICATIONS OF PAYMENT OF PARKING CHARGE AS EVIDENCE

26. (1) Where a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in the Schedules to this Order during the permitted hours and payment of the parking charge is made an indication shall appear on the hand held device that the vehicle has an active registered session from either payment method under Article 21 (1) or Article 21(2) of this Order.

(2) Where a vehicle is left in a parking place specified in the Schedules to this Order during the permitted hours an indication shall appear on the hand held device that the vehicle has registered a free parking period
27. Subject to Articles 29 and 35 of this Order, should no indication appear on the hand held device that payment of the parking charge has been made or an indication that the parking period for which payment of the parking charge was made has expired it shall be presumed unless the contrary is proved, that either -
 - (a) the parking charge has not been duly paid in respect of that vehicle, or
 - (b) the parking period for which payment of the parking charge was made has already expired, or
 - (c) the free parking period has not been registered, or
 - (d) the free parking period has expired.

PARKING PERMITS

- 28 Any person meeting such criteria shall, from time to time, be advised by the Council that they may apply to the Council for the issue of a parking permit for the leaving of a vehicle in a parking place specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order
- (a) An application shall be made by completing an online form via a registered account on the Council's website and shall include all information required by such form.
 - (b) The application shall be accompanied by a remittance for such appropriate pre-payment fee as specified in Column 3 of Schedule 3 of this Order.
 - (c) Confirmation of a successful application for an e-permit shall be indicated by a confirmation message sent to the applicant's registered online account.
 - (d) An e- permit shall be,
 - i. registered to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued, and
 - ii. in respect of whom it was issued, and
 - iii. the period during which it has been granted, and
 - iv. the parking place in respect of which it was issued.

EXEMPTIONS FROM PARKING CHARGE

- 29
- (a) Any disabled person's vehicle left in a parking place displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge shall be exempt from the parking charge unless the said parking place is not exempt from payment as specified in Column 4 of Schedule 1 to this Order,
 - (b) Without prejudice to paragraph (a) of this Article a disabled person's vehicle to which paragraph (a) applies shall use the parking place in accordance with all other provisions of this Order;
 - (c) Any vehicle left in a parking place that has e-permit issued by the Council for use in that parking place at that time shall be exempt from the parking charge.

MANNER OF STANDING IN A PARKING PLACE

30. Each vehicle left in a parking place shall so stand that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking bay, provided that in the case of any parking place where the length of any vehicle precludes it from standing wholly within the limits of a parking bay, that vehicle shall so stand in the parking bay that as much of the vehicle as possible is within the limits of the parking bay and that such portion as is beyond the limits of the parking bay and does not constitute a danger or obstruction to other users of the parking place

ALTERATION OF POSITION OF VEHICLE IN PARKING PLACES

31. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of Article 30 of this Order any person authorised by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions and may recover any expenses associated with this alteration.

32. Where any person authorised by the Council is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place and, where it is so removed, shall provide for the safe custody of the vehicle. Any expenses incurred by the Council in removing a vehicle from any parking place shall be recoverable by the Council from the owner of the vehicle.
33. The Council may as respects to a vehicle which has been removed from a parking place in pursuance of Article 32 of this Order, if it appears to them to have been abandoned, sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle after having made reasonable enquiries to ascertain the name and address of the owner of the vehicle in accordance with the procedure set out in the Refuse Disposal (Amenity) Act 1978.
34. Any person removing the vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Articles 32 and 33 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

POWER TO SUSPEND PARKING PLACES

35. (a) Any person authorised by the Council may, subject to such conditions or exceptions as he considers appropriate, suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever such suspension is considered reasonably necessary,
- (b) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of the preceding paragraph shall place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to any part of the parking place the use of which has been suspended a sign to indicate that the parking place or any part thereof is suspended,
- (c) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any part of a parking place which has been suspended in accordance with the provisions of this Article except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council

REMOVAL OF NOTICES

36. Where a notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle or a Civil Enforcement Officer, shall remove the notice from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DRIVER

37. The person who was driving the vehicle at the time when it was left in the parking place shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of all relevant Articles of this Order and unless proved to the contrary the registered keeper of the vehicle shall be deemed to be the driver of that vehicle.

DISCLAIMER

38. The Council shall not be held liable for any damages to loss of or theft from any vehicle in any parking place.

REVOCATION OF EXISTING ORDERS.

39 The Orders specified in Schedule 4 to this order are revoked in their entirety

EXEMPTIONS IN OTHER ORDERS

40 Insofar as there are any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Order and the exemptions contained in any other Order made or having effect as if made under the Act, the provisions of this Order shall prevail

41 This Order supersedes any statutory provision currently in force which is affected by this Order and the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
